Liquid.

Gas.

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Acute Health Effects:

Irritating to eyes.

Harmful by inhalation and if swallowed.

Can be absorbed through skin.

FIRST AID

Swallowed:

Contact doctor or Poisons Centre.

Give glass of water.

Eye:

Wash with running water (15 mins).

Medical attention.

Skin:

Wash with soap & water.

Apply cleansing cream.

Inhaled:

Fresh air.

Rest, keep warm.

If breathing shallow, give oxygen.

Medical attention.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Engineering Controls:

General Exhaust Ventilation adequate.

Glasses:

Not normally required.

Chemical goggles.

Gloves:

1. NEOPRENE

Respirator:

Type AX-P Filter of sufficient capacity

Flammability:

In use, may form flammable/ explosive vapour- air mixture.

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

Storage & Transport:

Keep container in a well ventilated place.

Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs.

Store in cool, dry, protected area.

Spills & Disposal:

Eliminate ignition sources.

Prevent from entering drains.

Contain spillage by any means.

Absorb with dry agent.

Stop leak if safe to do so.

Take off immediately all contaminated clothing.

To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and

detergent.

Fire/Explosion Hazard:

Highly flammable.

Toxic smoke/ fumes in a fire.

Risk of explosion if heated under confinement.

Fire Fighting:

Keep containers cool.

Water spray/ fog.
